Young up and coming winemaker Juan Antonio Ponce is a passionate advocate of the native grape variety, Bobal and learnt many of his skills from his father. He has also studied and travelled extensively in France and, like peers such as Daniel Jimenez Landi and Jose Luis Mateo, he has been seduced by the theories of biodynamics. Clos Lojen is a fresh example of Bobal grown in this way. The other 3 wines are single vineyard expressions of Bobal, each showing the difference in their provenance.
