Grapes are sourced from the Carraelciego vineyard located at the foothills of the Sierra Cantabria mountains, to the south of the river Ebro. The climate is moderate continental and the altitude varies from 500 to 750 metres above sea level. The soil is composed of clay and limestone and annual rainfall is around 500 litres per square meter.

VITICULTURE: _____

The viticulture is traditional.

WINEMAKING: _____

The grapes used for this wine come from the estate's youngest vines. After destemming the grapes undergo 5-6 days of cold maceration, being pumped-over three times a day. Fermentation takes place over 7-8 days at between 25-28° C, then the wine is racked to stainless steel vats where malolactic fermentation takes place.
