

HOLOCENE - MOTHER ROCK WINES

Coastal Region



APPELLATION: Swartland

BLEND: Carignan (50%), Mourvèdre (43%) and Cinsault (7%)

WINEMAKER: Johan Meyer

VINEYARD: _____

Grapes are sourced from a single vineyard on the outskirts of Malmesbury in the Swartland appellation. Soils are decomposed granite with some Malmesbury shale.

VITICULTURE: _____

This vineyard is uncertified organic. All grapes were handpicked in three phases and placed into lug boxes (smaller quantities mean reduced compaction and damage to the fruit) and then moved to cellar.

WINEMAKING: _____

100% of the grapes are whole bunch fermented. Ageing takes place in old 500-litre French oak barrels for 10 months, after which it is bottled without fining or filtering.



This wine is suitable for vegans and vegetarians.

TASTING NOTES: _____

A charming nose of black pepper, red and black fruits and earthy spice. Incredibly pure fruit, fresh acidity and fine tannins. Elegant and grippy.
