VINEYARD: _____

Will and Rachel buy small parcels of grapes from established vineyards in special sites to make the very best wine they can. Rather than focus on whole vineyards, they think in terms of small parcels within vineyards. Fruit for this wine was sourced from three very expressive but different vineyard sites within the Southern Valley's area in Marlborough, planted at altitudes ranging from 60 to 120 metres above sea level. Each fruit parcel brings a unique fruit characteristic. Soils are alluvial clay.

WINEMAKING: _____

Grapes are 100% destemmed, and undergo a cold soak before indigenous fermentation takes place in small stainless steel vats. Ageing is 100% in French barriques for 11 months. 30% oak is new.
