

# DARIO - BODEGAS MARAÑONES

Castilla y León

Morenillo, sometimes called Morate, is an almost extinct variety which some liken to Pinot Noir. Fruit for this wine come from an east facing site at around 770 metres between Toledo and Ávila where the Sierra de Gredos and the Sierra de Guadarrama merge in San Martín de Valdeiglesias. Soils are weathered granite and the climate is continental.

Viticulture is uncertified organic.

**WINEMAKING:** \_\_\_\_\_

Grapes are de-stemmed and undergo cold maceration before fermentation with indigenous yeasts. It is then aged for 12 months in 500 litre old French oak barrels. Bottled without fining or filtration.
