BLEND: Cabernet Sauvignon

VINEYARD: _____

Grapes are sourced from Payten & Jones vineyards in a warmer part of the Yarra Valley. It receives most rainfall in the winter and spring, and has relatively cool, dry and humid summers. There is limited maritime influence. Vines are 30 years old and unirrigated.

VITICULTURE: _____

Conventional farming no insecticides.

WINEMAKING: _____

Grapes are mostly de-stemmed and fermented with little extraction. A small percentage was kept whole bunch and blended in afterwards, before resting in old oak hogsheads. Wines are bottled without fining or filtration and with just a small addition of SO₂.
