APPELLATION: Beaujolais-Lantignié

BLEND: Gamay

WINEMAKER: Jean-Philippe and Jean-Guillaume Bret

VINEYARD: _____

Lantignié is one of just 38 villages allowed to attach its name to the Beaujolais Villages communal appellation. The altitude here is higher than other surrounding villages, and the grapes are planted on a distinctive mix of pink granite and sandstone.

VITICULTURE: _____

Viticulture is sustainable.

WINEMAKING: _____

Grapes are hand harvested as whole-bunches and fermented carbonically with indigenous yeasts. Bottled with no fining or filtration, just a minimal addition of sulphur.
