VINEYARD: _____

Grapes come from a small vineyard called Kleinplasië. The current vineyard was established in 2011, with bush vines planted on decomposed shale soils at an elevation of 209 metres.

VITICULTURE: _____

Viticulture is certified organic.

WINEMAKING: _____

The fruit is hand harvested, destemmed and pressed into a stainless-steel tank, where fermentation takes place naturally. Malolactic fermentation is blocked. The wine is aged in neutral vessels until bottling.

TASTING NOTES: _____

A fresh and light interpretation of Grenache Blanc, it's aromatic with a steely citrus character. The palate has ripe pear, yellow plum and some spice, cut with a pithy citrus finish.
