VINEYARD: _____

The vineyards are situated in Itata, an old and until recently forgotten viticultural valley 400 km south of Santiago. The Cinsault bush vines are over 60 years old, they're planted mid-slope on a thin layer of clay over granitic rock.

VITICULTURE: _____

Practicing organic, in the process of certification.

WINEMAKING: _____

The grapes are hand harvested, foot-stomped and direct basket pressed in concrete. Fermentation is with native yeasts, the wine is bottled under crown cap before it has fermented to dry, undergoing a second fermentation in bottle, to give a gentle pétillance.
