

BRUTAL! RED - MOTHER ROCK WINES

Coastal Region



APPELLATION: Swartland

BLEND: Cinsault

VINEYARD: _____

Grapes are sourced from three vineyards around Paardersberg, between Paarl and Malmesbury, all planted on south-facing slopes. The vines range between 40-50 years old. Soils are a mix of decomposed granite, Malmesbury shale, Koffie Klip and clay.

VITICULTURE: _____

Practicing organic.

WINEMAKING: _____

Grapes were handpicked early in the morning during cooler weather. The grapes are pressed onto dried Carignan skins, and the wine undergoes a warm 30 degree ferment for around 10 days, and spends a further 22 days on skins post-ferment. Ageing takes place on its gross lees in old 500-litre French oak barrels for 11 months, after which it is bottled unfinned and unfiltered.



This wine is suitable for vegans and vegetarians.

TASTING NOTES: _____

Bright, crunchy and mingling cranberry and sloe fruit characters with a savoury herbal finish and lightly chalky tannins, chill it down and try not to finish it too quickly!
