APPELLATION: Vino de España

BLEND: Treixadura

VINEYARD: _____

Ribeiro sits on the eastern edge of Galicia, and is divided by three rivers. Grapes for this wine are sourced from vineyards on the banks of the Arnoia river, with vines ranging from 10-30 years old. Soils here are granite and the climate is Atlantic.

VITICULTURE: _____

Viticulture is sustainable, no herbicides or pesticides are used in the vineyards.

WINEMAKING: _____

After hand-picking the grapes are fermented with wild yeasts in a variety of vessels: 600-litre neutral oak barrels, 1,200 and 2,400 litre foudres, cement eggs and stainless steel tanks. It is unfinned and lightly filtered. Only 4,000 bottles are produced.

Textured and full of ripe green pear, white peach and creamy nougat notes with a citrusy finish. An excellent food wine.
